Passenger Carrying Vehicle Driving (Bus or Coach) (QCF)

The Passenger Carrying Vehicle Driving (Bus or Coach) QCF is a practical work-based qualification that is recognised by employers throughout the UK. It is awarded to people who have proved their skills, knowledge and understanding of all aspects of their job. This qualification will demonstrate to the world that you are occupationally competent in your job role as a driver.

What you will have to do?

You will attend a short induction, followed by a period of training to cover the knowledge and skills needed to achieve your qualification.

You will then be allocated an assessor who will observe and assess you in the workplace carrying out your normal working activities, the jobs you do day-in day-out, such as:

- Health and Safety of yourself and others
- Preparing your vehicle for passenger carrying journeys
- Operating your vehicle
- Driving your vehicle in a safe and fuel efficient manner
- Dealing with and emergencies or incidents during your journeys
- Dealing with customers
- Share information on the operation of your vehicle service

It is not 'pass or fail'; you will receive coaching if you are not ready for any element of the qualification.

Once you have been assessed, your assessor will complete your qualification by having the evidence you have generated verified and applying to the Awarding Body for your certificate.

Gaining your Level 2 Qualification will support you to progress to gain a Level 3 Qualification.
