Teaching Award Level 3 Level 3 Award in Education and Training (QCF)

The Level 3 Award in Education and Training (QCF) has been design to provide an introduction to teaching for individuals who would like to work or currently work with FE Colleges, Independent Training Providers and/or Local Authorities.

It can meet the needs of a range of trainee teachers, such as:

- Individuals not currently teaching or training
- Individuals currently teaching and training
- Individuals currently working as assessors who wish to achieve a qualification that provides an introduction to teaching.

Entry Requirements

Although there are no formal entry requirements for this course learners need to be reminded than an appropriate level of English, maths and information technology skills will be required for the successful completion of the course. All units undertaken for this qualification are at Level 3 - this is the equivalent of the skills required at 'A' level. An initial assessment will take place in the first session.

Course Dates

This course will be delivered at SP Training, Carlisle Airport Business Park, over five dates.

Qualification Structure

This qualification is made up of a series of units, which make up a total of 12 credits. The units chosen for this course are:

- Unit 1 Understanding roles, responsibilities and relationships in education and training (3 credits)
- Unit 2 Understanding and using inclusive teaching and learning approaches in education and training (6 credits)
- Unit 5 Understanding assessment in education and training (3 credits)

How is the qualification assessed?

Through a portfolio of evidence which demonstrates the learner has met the required assessment criteria. Learners will be expected to apply and show evidence of both theoretical and practical knowledge in their portfolio. You will also be expected to prepare and deliver a micro-teach session of approximately 30 minutes to the rest of the group. This will be observed by the tutor and the other learners on the course. You will be expected to write feedback/evaluation on each micro-teaching session, whether you are the deliverer or an observer, as evidence for your portfolio.

Will I have to study at home?

Yes. As well as classroom delivery by a tutor this course also includes self-study time for research, preparation of micro-teaching activities and assignment writing for completion of a portfolio.

What next?

Learners may wish to progress to a further qualification such as Level 4 Certificate in Education and Training (QCF)
