Learners will also attain the CMI L3 leadership qualification, a widely recognised credential upon program completion.

QUALIFICATIONS



This Apprenticeship offers learners the opportunity to gain the **Level 3 CMI Certificate in Management and Leadership**.

Managing Safely in Logistics (MSiL) is focused on managing and operating safely within the logistics environment. Optional additional element, delivered remotely over 3 days. (Additional cost of £360 + VAT PP)

COURSE DETAILS

The learning element of the course will be delivered over **12 months**, where the learner will attend 1 half day theory-based lesson a month delivered via ZOOM by an expert subject Tutor. The learner will also complete modules of self directed online learning on our online platform OLLIE and complete workplace activities set by the Tutor at a time that suits the learner and the employer.

There is then an **End Point Assessment** which takes place after the 12 months of learning. This includes an improvement project in the form of a 4,000 word report so the learner must have the opportunity to carry this out. The EPA can take up to 4 months.



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The learner must be exposed to relevant work experience in their current role to be able to meet the standards of the apprenticeship.

We require all candidates to hold (and show proof of) a minimum of a GCSE grade C/4/functional Skills level 2 in at least one of the following subject areas before enrolment; Maths and English.

For those who need to complete either Maths or English at grade C, **Functional Skills tuition** is available from our specialist tutors, who will support you to complete the final exam.

If a candidate requires functional skills support they will be required to take an initial assessment to determine whether they are eligible to be enrolled on programme.

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PROGRAMME DELIVERY

Learners will participate in a blended mix of tutor led sessions and online interactive learning via our bespoke platform **OLLIE**.

ASSESSMENT METHODS

Learners will be subject to an End Point Assessment (EPA) which will consist of;

A multiple-choice test of 25 questions over 60 mins

A project report (max 4000 words) based on a real-life or recurring organisational issue, a specific problem or an idea/opportunity

A presentation (15 mins) and a minimum of 5 questions (25 mins)

An interview to assess learner competence against the knowledge, skills and behaviours gained across the program.

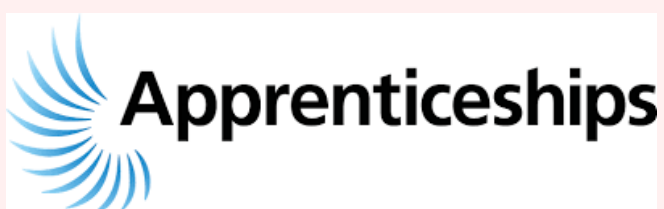
COSTS / APPRENTICESHIP LEVY

If your business pays into the **Apprenticeship Levy**, the cost of the training is fully funded. If you do not pay into the levy then the government still covers 95% of the costs so the course fees will only be £250

WHAT'S NEXT?

Upon successful completion of this **level 3 apprenticeship** the learner may go on to apply for positions within your business at **Warehouse or Operations Manager** level.

They may also wish to go on to study the **Level 5 Operations / Departmental Manager apprenticeship** where they will obtain on completion, Chartered Management Status CMger CMI which would normally cost over £700 pounds



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
